Description

The Board of Directors of Accord Customer Care Solutions Limited (the "Company") wishes to inform that the Singapore Exchange Securities Trading Limited ("SGX-ST") has granted the Company an extension to 30 September 2005 (the "Extension") to announce its financial statements for the second quarter ended 30 June 2005 ("2QFY05 Results").

As stated in the announcement on 15 June 2005, the Company will finalise and release the financial statements for the first quarter ended 31 March 2005 ("1QFY05 Results") by 31 August 2005. As the Company would be presenting year-to-date results in its announcement of the 2QFY05 Results, the 1QFY05 Results would have to be completed before the 2QFY05 Results can be finalised. Accordingly, the Extension was sought as the Company would not be able to finalise its 2QFY05 Results and release the 2QFY05 Results by the time frame prescribed in the Listing Manual of the SGX-ST.

The Company and each of its directors confirm that it/he is not aware of any information that will have a material bearing on the Company's investors' decision which has yet to be announced.
